# Overview Borough of Weatherly

The Borough of Weatherly is located in Carbon County, Pennsylvania with an approximate population of approximately 2,639 residents. Just 8 miles southeast of Hazleton and 44 miles north of Allentown. Weatherly is situated at an elevation of 1,100 feet in the Ridge-and-Valley Province of the Appalachian Mountains, between Spring Mountain and Round Head Mountain to the north and Broad Mountain to the south. Weatherly was founded by Benjamin Romig in 1825 through the purchase of a 400-acre piece of land. The Borough of Weatherly was then incorporated on October 8th, 1863. Starting with the timbering industry and moving forward with the development of the railroad and transportation of coal, the population of the town grew dramatically. Throughout the years, Weatherly remains a rural community of people that love their legacy, cherish the wholesome lifestyle, and bask in the beauty of their natural surroundings.

#### Police Department Fleet

The Weatherly Police Department currently maintains a fleet of Ford police vehicles. The department has several fully marked patrol units for patrol operations. The department also has unmarked police vehicles that are utilized for patrol and special operations. The department also secured a fully operational crimes scene unit as well all-terrain vehicles for specialized needs of the department.

All vehicle utilized for patrol are equipped for the everyday tasks to protect not only the citizens of Weatherly but as well as surrounding communities when requested to assist. The vehicles are equipped with computers, video/ audio recording, radios, medical and trauma supplies, fire suppression equipment, patrol rifles/ shot guns and spike strips.

# **School Zone Safety**

Weatherly has three schools in the borough, making up the Weatherly Area School District. The Weatherly Area School District is a public school district in Carbon County, Pennsylvania. It is centered on Weatherly and also serves the borough of East Side, plus Lehigh, Packer, Lausanne, and northern Kidder Townships. The district features one elementary school, one middle school, and one high school.



Officers provide routine patrol throughout the school day and targeted enforcement of both pedestrian and vehicular traffic during the arrival and dismissal of students each day. The officers also provide periodic school checks which include a walk-through of the school checking in with faculty and staff and making sure doors are secured. Officers also get to interact with the students in a positive environment which promotes better community relations. Weatherly Police try to leave a positive impact on students despite unique and increasing challenges placed on our youth today.

#### **Public Information**

#### **Medicine Box**

The Weatherly Borough Police Department Cabinet for medication drop off. located in the main lobby of the Weatherly Borough building and police station. It can be accessed 24 hours a day 7days a week 365 days a year. Pills can be left in original containers or placed in a bag.

Please refrain from dropping liquids and or saves and creams in the box

Weatherly Borough Police Department collected approximately 57 lbs. of pills/ capsules, and several boxes of syringes, epi pens, lancets and patches in 2022.

#### **Property Checks**

When you are planning away from your home for a period of time for any reason, the Weatherly Police Department will periodically check your residence and notify you or your designee if any serious problems are discovered.

- Property checks are offered to Weatherly Borough residents free of charge.
  - Property Check submissions must have an end date specified.
- As call volume allows, Officers will perform periodic inspections of your property while you are away.

#### **Property checks include:**

- A perimeter check consisting of a physical and/or visual check of all doors and windows
  - Verification of vehicles left on the property
- Verification of any people found on the property -\*Should the need arise; we will have the information available to contact you or another responsible party.
- Only portions of the residential property with direct access will be checked by Officers


#### The Property Check service is NOT:

    - A substitute for an alarm system
  - For properties in which someone is staying at the residence


# **Assisting Other Law Enforcement**

The Weatherly Borough Police Department is comprised of several men and women who work day in and day out to provide the best services possible to the Borough of Weatherly. The officers also have the same dedication and core values when called upon to provide assistance to their agencies and communities. It is an honor to have such a great working relationship with not only neighboring department but also neighboring states. Weatherly Police Department assists multiple state and federal agencies on a multitude of different calls and incidents. Some of these agencies require types of assistance that only Weatherly Police Department can offer such as use of specialized equipment, working as part of a designated task force, or use of technology that nobody else in surrounding areas possess, like a mobile fingerprint identification device.





Weatherly Police Department assisted federal, state, and local law enforcement a total of 73 calls of assistance.



Weatherly Police Department had a call volume of approximately 3,200 incidents for the year of 2021. These calls and incidents range in severity from traffic warnings to violent crime and narcotics offenses.


#### Criminal Arrests for 2021

In 2021 Weatherly Police Department arrested approximately 60 offenders. These crimes range in severity from possession of narcotics to violent crime.

In 2021 approximately 40 offenders were placed in custody in our holding cells located at Weatherly Police Department.

These criminal arrests added up to 312 criminal charges filed.






A total of 381 traffic citations for violations of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code were issued and filed for the year of 2021.






A total of 370 warnings were given for motor vehicle violations for the year of 2021.




A total of 67 Non-Traffic citations were filed for the year of 2021.

# **Impound Report**

Weatherly Police Department is unique in that it has its own impound lot which is managed solely by Weatherly Police personnel. A vehicle will be impounded if it was used in the commission of a crime or if it is illegally parked at the time a violation occurs and it is unable to be removed to a location which is legal parking zone, such as the operator not having a valid license.



Weatherly Police Department impounded approximately 65 vehicles for the year 2021.
